What it's for, how to apply, and requirements.

Engineering Organization Fund

What you can use it for:

- Project Materials
- Software
- Supplies for Outreach
- Project needs
- Scholarship Funds
- MANY other things!

What you CANNOT:

- ANY expenses for a conference
- Gifts (grad cords, medals, etc.)
- ANY merchandise or promotional material

Other Funds

International Humanitarian

- Funds dedicated to international aid through service projects, educational efforts, or improving infrastructure

Lynn Nystrom Fund

- ALL conference and competition related expenses for student orgs, researchers, and design teams
- NO food/gas/unrelated expenses
- MUST have a VT Foundation account

Need - 50%

- Line Item Proposals
- Budget
- Funding Sources
- Fiscal History

Footprint - 30%

- Team size
- Representation
- Team Success
- Growth/Progress
- Community Outreach

Involvement - 20%

- GAM Attendance (2 this semester)
- SEC Event Attendance
- SEC Participation/Volunteer*

80% rule : EO should have used 80% of funds from previous cycle by application deadline of current funding cycle

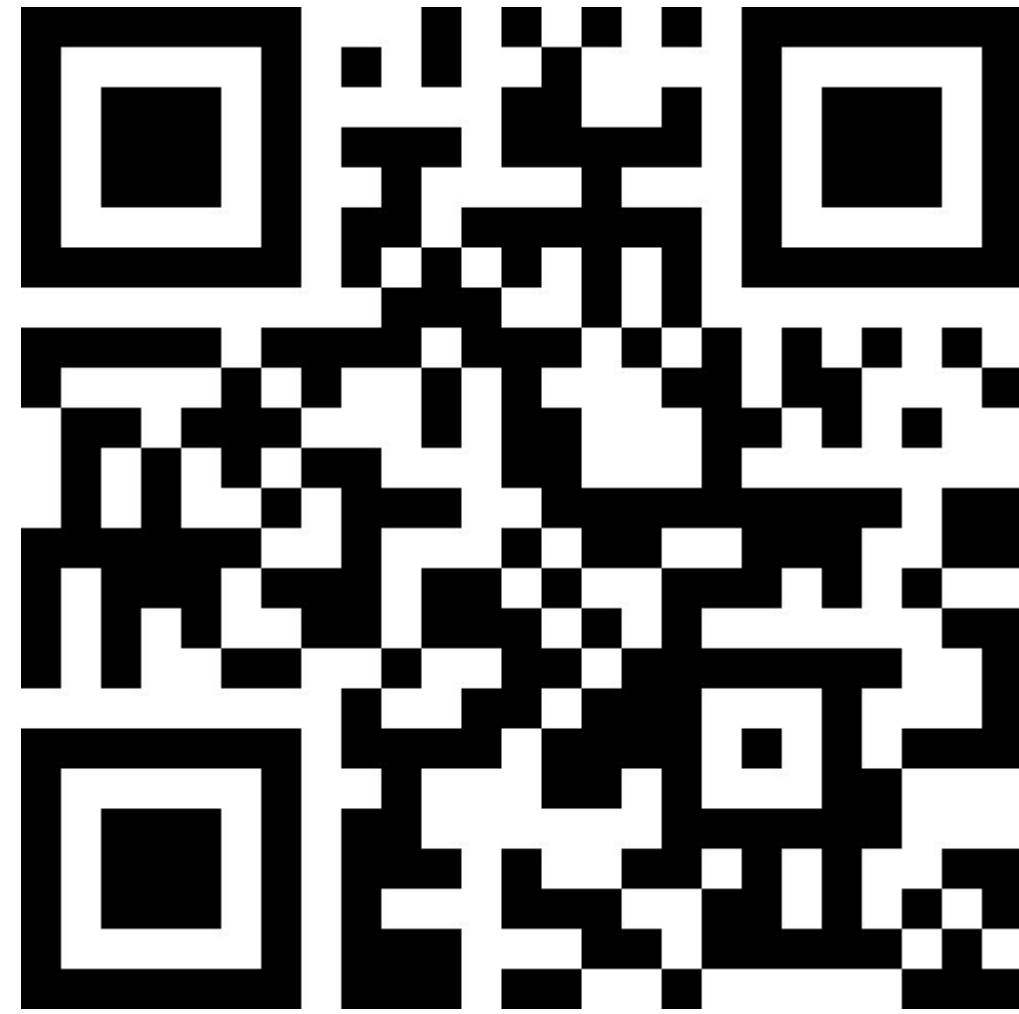
